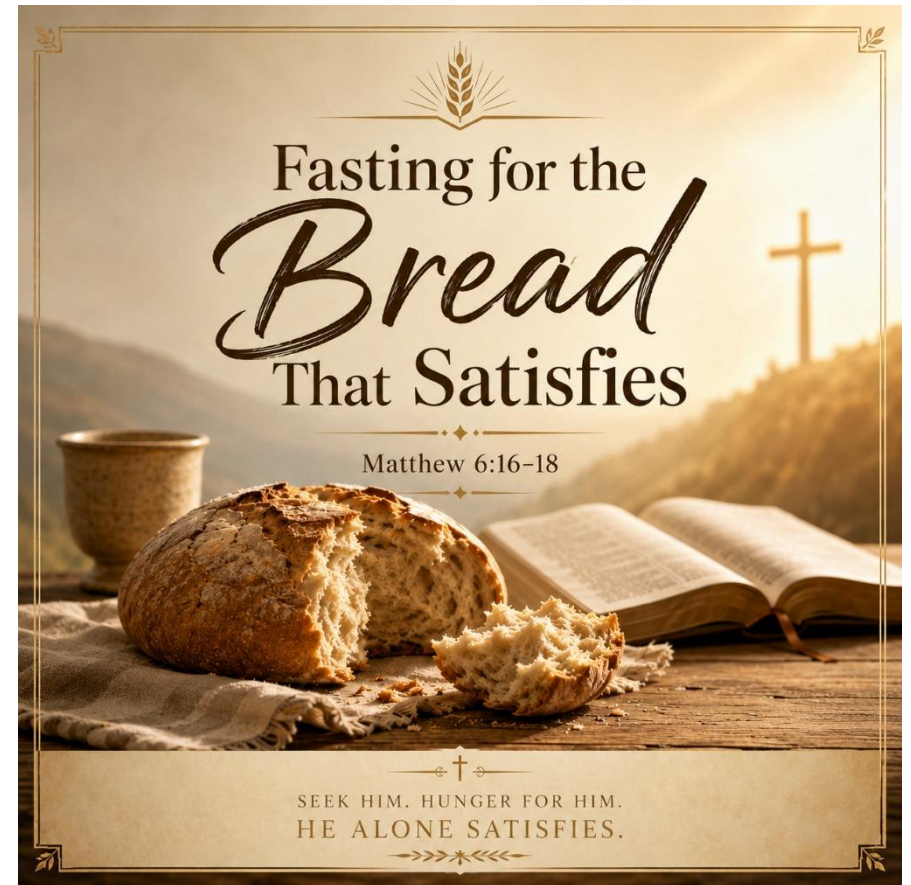

Q. What is the Lord's Supper?

A. The Lord's Supper is an ordinance of the New Testament established by Jesus Christ. In it, believers receive bread and wine according to His command, proclaiming His death. Those who receive the Supper rightly do not physically partake of Christ's body and blood, but by faith share in Christ and all the benefits of His saving work, receiving spiritual nourishment and growing in grace.

Q. Who should participate in the Lord's Supper?

A. Those who have personally professed faith in Jesus Christ and turned from sin in repentance.

Q. What is required to receive the Lord's Supper rightly?

A. Those who participate in the Lord's Supper should examine themselves to be sure that they understand the meaning of Christ's body and death, trust in Him by faith, repent of their sins, love God and others, and seek to live in obedience to Christ. Otherwise, by participating in an unworthy manner, they bring judgment upon themselves.
